No testing will be done on the site this week.

Testing is on schedule for GFA to deliver the initial certified groundwater and soil test results during January 2018.

The January date, time, and location of the public meeting will be announced soon, and the media and public will be notified as soon as that date is available. Public communication will include direct mail, flyers, announcements at community meetings, and social media channels.
