## **South Street Environmental Testing**

### **Week of December 18, 2017**

No testing was done on the site last week.

On December 22, a letter was mailed to residents in the neighborhood surrounding the South Street site. The letter provided an update on the testing and a link to Lee County's Consumer Confidence Report, the water quality report assessing the water provided to the neighborhood. The letter assures residents that Lee County has assessed their drinking water, and it meets the standards for potable drinking water as with any other neighborhood that LCU services.

The letter also requested that the City would like to test private wells in the surrounding area. Some residents may have irrigation wells and other residents may still be using wells for drinking water despite the availability of a public water supply. The letter encourages residents with private wells to contact the City to request testing or for more information on the testing procedure.

On December 22, GFA provided the City with the results of round two of groundwater testing. The results are posted on the website [www.cityftmyers.com](http://www.cityftmyers.com) (scroll down to South Street Environmental Testing link).

### **Week of December 25, 2017**

No testing will be done on the site this week.

Testing is on schedule for GFA to deliver the initial certified groundwater and soil test results during January 2018.

### **January 2018 – Public Meeting**

The January date, time, and location of the public meeting will be announced soon, and the media and public will be notified as soon as that date is available. Public communication will include direct mail, flyers, announcements at community meetings, and social media channels.

### **More About the Assessment**

The South Street environmental site assessment is a collaborative effort between the City and the FDEP.
