This letter is in response to your letter of March 12, 2018. The City of Fort Myers is committed to the voluntary clean-up of the lime sludge from the site.

As you are aware the City has been diligently working on a plan for the voluntary removal of the sludge at the South Street Site. The City of Fort Myers is currently pursuing negotiations with several disposal options. It is anticipated that the negotiations will continue for the next two or three weeks.

When a disposal option has been selected we will notify FDEP and provide a voluntary removal and disposal plan.

In the interim, the City will test monitoring wells 1-10 for arsenic, radium 226/228, iron, aluminum, manganese, TDS, and molybdenum by the end of April.
